Common Questions and Objections – Homosexuality and the Bible

1. Jesus never said anything about homosexuality.
2. What if it is determined that homosexuality is the result of a genetic predisposition?
3. Homosexuality is no more unnatural than an inclination to be left-handed, to be born with red hair or to like a particular food.
4. Why would God make me gay if being gay is a sin?
5. What about Jonathan and David? Didn't they have a homosexual relationship?

6. The bible only mentions homosexuality 6 times. How could it be so important?
7. "Homosexual" wasn't even a word when the bible was written. The first time it was put in the bible was in the 1950's, so the bible is not talking about the same thing.
8. The Old Testament passages that forbid homosexuality also say not to eat shellfish or make clothes made from two different fibers. Why should we ignore one and embrace the other?
9. The bible contains multiple definitions of marriage. How do we know which one is correct or if any one is more correct than another?
10. Why do Christians care so much about homosexual relationships? They're not affecting you.
11. I think Jesus really cares about our hearts not our sexuality.
