1Co 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand,


1Co 15:2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.,

1Co 15:7 After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. 1Co 15:8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.



"and ten thousand other wonderful things concerning him." (Antiquities.xviii.33)






1Pe 1:22 Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,

Rom 1:19 because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.



Rom 1:22 Professing to be wise, they became fools,


Rom 1:23 and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.



Mat 7:13 "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.


